Preface

This document, the Finding Aid for the Gettysburg National Military Park, Park Maps and Drawings, 1933-Present describes maps and architectural drawings documenting the work of the National Park Service at Gettysburg during the first two decades of the agency's administration of the national military park.

This document represents many hours of work recording details about the items herein described. The reader should expect a reasonable degree of human error and consequently rely on personal observation of the actual items.

Restrictions

Use and Access to Archeology Associated Documentation

Access to Information contained in this collection is restricted by The Archeological Resources Protection Act of 1979, (ARPA) (16 United States Code § 470aa-mm). Because of the statutory restriction against its release to the public, information in this collection is exempted from the Freedom of Information Act (5 United States Code § 552). Relevant sections from ARPA and the National Park Service Museum Handbook are provided below as a guide.:

From United States Code Title 16 Chapter 1b:
§ 470hh. Confidentiality of information concerning nature and location of archaeological resources.

(a) Disclosure of information

Information concerning the nature and location of any archaeological resource for which the excavation or removal requires a permit or other permission under this chapter or under any other provision of Federal law may not be made available to the public under subchapter II of chapter 5 of title 5 or under any other provision of law unless the Federal land manager concerned determines that such disclosure would -

- (1) further the purposes of this chapter or the Act of June 27, 1960 (16 U.S.C. 469-469c) (16 U.S.C. 469-469c-1), and
- (2) not create a risk of harm to such resources or to the site at which such resources are located.

(b) Request for disclosure by Governors

Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this section, upon the written request of the Governor of any State, which request shall state -

- (1) the specific site or area for which information is sought,
- (2) the purpose for which such information is sought,
- (3) a commitment by the Governor to adequately protect the confidentiality of such information to protect the resource from commercial exploitation, the Federal land manager concerned shall provide to the Governor information concerning the nature and location of archaeological resources within the State of the requesting Governor.

Introduction

This document, the Finding Aid Park Maps and Drawings, 1933-Present, is the result of work by the staff of Gettysburg National Military Park. These records (GETT 41107) document the activities of the National Park Service in its first two decades of managing the resources of Gettysburg National Military Park.

The records were originally stored in the archives storage building at the park. Previously they had been stored in the Maintenance Building in the Historian's Office.

During the summer of 2003, Museum Technician Beth Trescott and seasonal Museum Aids Emma Young and Leah Christie re-housed the maps and drawings, labeled and bar-coded file drawers, and created a draft arrangement scheme. Greg Goodell, park archivist, finalized this arrangement scheme and completed this finding aid in the fall of 2003. Beth Trescott finalized automated catalog records at this time and made accretions to the list in 2007-08, as well. During the Fall of 2012, Andrew Newman, Museum Technician, created final arrangement and organization of the maps and drawings in their present area, the Park Visitor Center. Secretions will be made when necessary as this collection is an on-going collection.

The materials were processed according to NPS, NMSC, and park archival standards. All re-housing, arranging of materials and cataloging into the Collections Management Module of the Automated National Catalog System Plus (ANCS+) at the collection level for submission to the National Catalog were carried out by park staff.

Description: The Gettysburg National Military Park Maps and Drawings, 1933-Present describes maps, plot plans, architectural drawings, engineering plans, road layouts, and topographic sketches of various buildings, monuments, and land tracts within Gettysburg National Military Park and the surrounding area (including the Borough of Gettysburg).

These items document the architectural and engineering work of the National Park Service in the Gettysburg National Military Park, the identification of lands for acquisition in the area surrounding the park, and the synthesis/delivery of interpretive information by NPS staff for the public. A number of drawings document the work of the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) and the Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Public Roads in the park in the 1930's and early 1940's as part of the New Deal. Finally, there are two drawings documenting the work done by the park in its administration of the Antietam National Battlefield and Cemetery in the 1930's.

Organization: Gettysburg Park Maps and Drawings, 1933-Present is organized into two primary sub-series: numbered maps and drawings and un-numbered maps and drawings. Arrangement with each sub-series differs, however. The sub-series of numbered maps and drawings are arranged by NPS assigned drawing number. This is a three, four, or five-digit number preceded by the prefix NMP-GET (i.e., NMP-GET-8980). There is not a particular chronological arrangement to the numbers within this sub-series. The sub-series of un-numbered maps and drawings is arranged by general

subject category and there under by drawing type (i.e., category Roads, Avenues, and Trails; folder "Planned Roads and Avenues").

Un-numbered maps and drawings subject Category Descriptions

ROADS, AVENUES, AND TRAILS

1. General

This category contains information on roads, avenues, and trails in and around the National Park at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. This includes specifications for grading, materials, and length of each road segment. There are also maps of various regions of the park depicting park roads within those regions, railroad layouts, and state highways. The roads which are addressed in this category include Baltimore Pike, Low Dutch Road, Road to Snyder Farm, Mummasburg Road, Buford Avenue, Jones Artillery Ave., Hospital Rd., Emmitsburg Rd., Wheatfield Rd., Springs Hotel Rd., and Mill Rd. The documents are generally in good condition.

2. Planned Roads and Avenues

This category contains information on planned or proposed changes, improvements, or additions to various park roads and walks. The documents show various types of changes to be made, including re-routing, re-grading, and the construction of bypasses within the bounds of the park. Of particular note is a group of drawings showing numerous projects undertaken for the park by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Bureau of Public Roads in 1935 as part of the New Deal. Roads and avenues covered include Hunt, Pleasanton, Williams, Slocum, Wainwright, Ayers, Brooke, Gregg, Warren, Chamberlain, Carman, Colgrove, Geary, Howard, Buford, North Confederate, Sykes, Sedgwick, and Birney Avenues, as well as East Cavalry, Hanover, Wheatfield, and Granite Schoolhouse Roads.

TOPOGRAPHIC MAPS

This category includes maps of Gettysburg and its environs, showing details in elevation as well as the general layout of buildings that existed at the time. These documents are helpful in showing what changes were made to lands for building purposes. Areas covered include Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) camps MP-1 and 2 (which existed in the park in the 1930's and early 1940's), entrance stations, guide stations, utility area, the Springs Hotel Road, Spangler's Spring, Oak Hill, Shultz's Woods, and Meade's Headquarters.

LANDS

1. Government - General

This category contains maps and drawings pertaining to the lands belonging to the National Park Service. There are tract layouts, maps showing land acquisitions, maps

showing potential properties for acquisition, and a map showing the location of agency areas for the 75th anniversary of the battle in 1938. There are not a large number of items included in this subject, and the specifics of each map vary greatly.

2. Government - Farmlands

This category contains maps of government-owned farms situated in the park. Not all government-owned farms within the park are represented. Those included are the McPherson, Culp, Weikert, Hummelbaugh, Biggs, Brian, Trostle, Klingel, Codori, Wentz, and Bushman. This category also contains drawings on standard type farm buildings constructed by the National Park Service.

Government - Rock Creek

This category contains documents pertaining to the area of Gettysburg National Military Park bordering Rock Creek. The contents are all from 1933, barring the series "General Plan for Proposed Development of Rock Creek," which is undated. The maps depict Rock Creek and tributaries, and show the location of the creek within the park.

4. Government - Boundary and Location Maps

This category contains thirty-five sheets showing the boundaries and locations for all of National Park Service land in and surrounding Gettysburg. These are the final drawings documenting a comprehensive survey completed in 1941 by Elvin W. Patterson.

Government – National Cemetery

This category contains maps and drawings documenting the administration and management of the National Cemetery, which was transferred to the National Park Service in 1933. Maps and drawings include cemetery drainage layouts, the location of utilities in the cemetery, road maps, diagrams of a removable rostrum, and the layout of burial sections.

6. Private - General

This category contains maps and drawings covering a large range of land holdings in the area of Gettysburg, Cumberland Township, and Adams County. The owners include, private individuals, companies such as the Gettysburg Water Company, railway corporations, and local Adams County governments. The park generated these maps in the process of determining property lines for properties adjacent to the park, identifying lands for potential acquisition, or as part of the acquisition process. Individuals property owners represented include William I. Shields, Mary R. Kissinger, Charles Redding, Paul S. Reaver, Roy C. Wolf, L.C. Knox, Charles J. Haines, B. Ronald McCleary and Katie Bixler, Luther Sachs, and Glenn R. Shields.

7. Lot Maps of Gettysburg Area

This category contains various maps of the Gettysburg Area showing structures in place in the period of 1933 and 1945. Buildings are numbered, but there is no key indicating the name or owner of the building.

BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

1. General

This category contains material pertaining to both physical structures and natural elements within the national military park. Natural subject matter includes the distribution map of plant material and tree conditions of the GNMP and a diagram depicting the essential factors of building a fertile soil. Architectural plans include two sheets of plans for a storage building and a sketch plan for the administration group. Miscellaneous materials include plans of Blacks Dam, Powers Hill Recreation Area, composite drawing for Spangler's Spring, a plan of tank installation at the Utility Building, and two proposed park storage and service area drawings.

2. Utility

This category contains a small sample of both proposed and constructed utilities throughout the park. These include water, power, and telephone lines contained within the areas of Spangler's Spring, East Cavalry Field, the Weikert House, the park's entrance stations and other various areas. The majority of the drawings and plans are undated.

3. Bridges

This category contains architectural sketches for both existing and proposed bridges in the park. The blue linen drawings in this category are similar to the original bridge designs of the Gettysburg National Park Commission and were likely created to show the conditions of those bridges at the start of National Park Service administration or as part of the various New Deal work projects undertaken in the 1930s. In particular, there are a number of drawings showing bridges crossing over Plum Run at Wheatfield Road, Warren, Crawford, and South Confederate Avenues. The majority of the bridge drawings are from 1935, with the exception of the Reynolds Avenue Bridge sketch (1939) and the undated bridge archetypes.

4. Stations (Including locations, planting, etc.)

This category documents the layout, elevation, and landscape plans for the various guide and comfort stations in the park. The park constructed these buildings in the 1930s in order to provide additional visitor services and to provide employment to individuals as part of the New Deal. These drawings show specific room layouts, dimensions, the location of utility lines and tanks at the stations, and roofing plans.

5. Plot Plans

This category contains the undated plot plans, elevations, and out building sketches for fifteen farm-tracts contained within the park. These tracing paper sketches are the first generation of the waxed linen prints contained in sub-series I, Numbered Maps and Drawings (NMP-GET- 2060, 8285 - 8291, 8294 - 8296, 8298, and 8301 - 8303).

The individual tracts include the Althoff Farm, Biggs Farm, Brian Farm, Bushman Farm, Codori Farm, Culp Farm, Hummelbaugh Farm, Klingel Farm, Masenheimer Farm, McPherson Barn, General Meade's Headquarters (Leister), Slyder Farm, Trostle Farm, Weikert Farm, and Wentz Farm. Each farm has its own folder, with the exception of the Althoff Farm, which has two folders—one consisting of the tracing paper sketches and another strictly containing blueprints. These drawings were likely created to document basic conditions on the farms owned by the government at the beginning of National Park Service administration. There are slight differences in information between the numbered and un-numbered drawings.

CYCLORAMA

INTERPRETIVE MAPS

This category contains maps and drawings created for early interpretive projects and document the action of the battle and campaign at Gettysburg. Of particular note is a waxed line copy of Elliott's map of the battlefield showing the locations of Confederate graves immediately after the battle.

MONUMENTS

This category documents projects (both proposed and completed) associated with monuments in the park. The majority of the drawings relate to work done by the park in the general monument area, such as a planting plan for the area surrounding the North Carolina Monument, proposed road relocations around the Pennsylvania State Memorial, as well as general maps of monument areas on Oak Hill and East Cavalry Field. Two drawings document repair work to monuments (the Peace Memorial and the General Wells Statue). The dates on these documents range from 1933-1940.

CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS (CCC)

This category contains maps and drawings documenting the location of and work conducted in two Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) camps located in the park from the mid 1930s through the early 1940s as part of the New Deal. In particular, there are layout maps for the two camps (MP-1 and MP-2), drawings for specific buildings within the camps, a map showing proposed work projects, and a diagram for a tree-hauling trailer (See GETT 41135 – General Historical Photographic Prints, 1863-1986 for additional documentation on CCC activities in the park).

Part 2:**Historical Note**

History of the Park Maps and Drawings, 1933-Present

Since its inception as a national military park in 1893, Gettysburg National Military Park has produced thousands of individual maps and drawings. These maps and drawings have covered a myriad of issues and serve as a valuable resource for not only understanding the park's built environment, but also the evolution of the park as an institution.

These drawings document the activities of the National Park Service in its administration of Gettysburg National Military Park during the period 1933 (the first year of NPS administration) to 1980. This series consists of two distinctive sub-series of records: numbered drawings and un-numbered drawings. While the substance of the records is similar across these two sub-series, they seemed to evolve distinctly.

When the National Park Service assumed control of the national military park in 1933, it inherited a number of drawings (over 1000) from the War Department, both the Office of the Quartermaster General and its predecessor, the Gettysburg National Park Commission. The NPS continued to create drawings to document everything from road projects, to building plans, to monument repairs, to interpretive walks across sections of the battlefield. At first, many of these drawings were generated by park historical staff, many working on New Deal projects funded by the Works Progress Administration (WPA) and the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC). At the same time, NPS regional and national design and construction offices also contributed to design for a number of park projects, creating documentation at those levels. In the years following the conclusion of the Second World War, the park continued to generate maps, primarily on properties that had either been purchased by the government or were being considered for purchase.

At some point during this period, it appears that the park undertook a program to gain better control over the numerous maps and drawings that it had inherited from the War Department or created as part of its own work. It assigned a distinctive three, four, or five digit number, preceded by "NMP-GET" to many of its drawings, including many generated by the Gettysburg National Park Commission (see GETT 41106 for these drawings. Although they each have "NMP-GET" number assigned to them, the drawings of the Gettysburg National Park Commission are cataloged as their own distinctive series in order to maintain their provenance and original order within the records of the GNPC.). This mirrored the numbering system used for drawings designed by the regional and national design and construction offices (and is similar to the system in use today by the National Park Service). The park did, however, fail to assign a number to a number of these important drawings. As a result, this series has two distinctive sub-series – one covering the numbered drawings, the other covering those without a distinctive number.
